The 87th Medical Detachment in Southwest Asia

After preparing supported 1st Armored Division units for deployment to Southwest Asia, the 87th Medical Detachment from the Nuernberg Dental Activity deployed to Saudi Arabia in support of Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm on Dec 8, 1990 and returned to Nuernberg May 8, 1991.

Team 3 of the 87th Medical Detachment saw over 4,000 patients in a variety of settings and took part in setting up eight different field dental clinics. These clinics ranged from very austere

one-chair clinics in GP small tents to large clinics in evacuation hospitals. Team members had to be highly adaptable in delivering dental care in a variety of conditions.

All dentists assigned to the team treated dental problems of Iraqi EPWs, assisted in the OR, and treated Allied soldiers and EPWs in the EMT section of the 148th Evacuation Hospital.




