Dichlorethylsulphide vapor was applied to the skin; 62, bare skin; 63, skin coated with water; 64, skin coated with sodium bicarbonate water paste; 65, skin coated with soap; 66, skin coated with kaolin water paste. The photograph was taken 7 days after the application. Note the lesion is greatest on the moistened skin (63), as compared with the bare skin (62). Kaolin restrains this somewhat (66). Sodium bicarbonate paste (64) is useless. Soap paste (65) is fairly efficient. (The figures in parentheses refer to experiments)
